



# MOVE-IN: TRASH / MAIL PICKUP

## TRASH/RECYCLING/BULK PICKUP

- Currently, trash pickup day is Monday. To ensure pickup, bins must be out before 6am on pickup date and put away after 7pm.
- Recycling is picked up every other week on Mondays
- Acceptable items to recycle are, plastics 1-7, cardboard, newspaper, office paper, paper bags, junk mail, magazines, phone books, glass bottles and jars.
- Unacceptable items include but are not limited to, batteries, chemicals, bubble wrap, oil, paint, plastic bags, diapers, Christmas lights, food soiled items, hardback books, trash, waxed cartons.
- Bulk pickup may be placed curbside on Mondays.
  - **Appliance Pick Up**

Appliances such as stoves and water heaters are collected curbside on customers' regular collection day. There is no additional charge, and customers do not need to call for collection.

Refrigerant-using appliances must be confirmed emptied of the chemical by a certified professional. Check Dallas-area yellow page listings under "Refrigerant Service" for local providers.
  - **Brush, Bulk Waste**

Brush (tree trimmings, limbs and branches) and bulk waste (items too large for green roll-out containers, including bagged or boxed material) will be collected weekly on customers' regular collection day. All limbs must be cut into 4-foot lengths and placed in bundles not exceeding 40 pounds to fit in a rear-end loader truck.
  - **Loose Bulk** items should be placed in boxes not exceeding 50 pounds for safe, manageable collection. (Boom truck/Grappler size limits: 2,000 lbs/item with a maximum length of 12 feet).

## MAIL PICK UP

- Mail is delivered daily Monday through Saturday
- To ensure delivery, please keep all vehicles at least 15 feet from your mailbox
